


Chlamydia Information for males



Chlamydia is an infection which one person can give to another through unprotected sex



Males and females can get Chlamydia



Unprotected sex is where a condom is not used for vaginal or anal sex



Some people who have Chlamydia do not show any signs



Some people with Chlamydia have pain in their tummy below the tummy button
or
pain when having a wee or having sex
or
pain in the testicles



To find out if you have Chlamydia, you need to give a wee sample.

1. The nurse will give you a pot to wee into
2. Go to the toilet and wee into the pot
3. Screw the lid on firmly
4. Give the pot of wee back to the nurse



If the test finds Chlamydia you will need a medication called antibiotics.



It is important that we know who else you have had sex with.

They may need our help as well



Using condoms every time you have sex can stop you getting Chlamydia

Using condoms will help stop lots of other infections you can get during sex
